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Logline: After returning from a successful heist, three criminals realize that they may have lost more money from their heist than they had originally stolen.

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INT. SKETCHY HIDEOUT - NIGHT

Two people in black, JAGGER (21) and AMELIA(22) kick open the side door of their warehouse. They each enter holding big bags loaded with cash, they drop their bags on the kitchen table. They pull off their masks.

JAGGER  
100 million dollars, bitches!

AMELIA  
Hell yeah!

Amelia high fives Jagger.

JAGGER  
This is the biggest haul we've ever gotten.

AMELIA  
God damn! We are so loaded.

ENZO (O.S)  
So the heist went well. Good job, you've made me a proud uncle.

ENZO (54), their boss sits at the end of table.

JAGGER  
It really did, Uncle Enzo. With this dough, I'm going to buy a Lambo.

AMELIA  
I'm going to buy a mansion. With a mini wine fridge.

ENZO  
I knew you kids could do it. Well done.

AMELIA  
Yeah, we were so prepared.

JAGGER  
Yeah. We got crowbars, ladders, zip-lines. . .

ENZO  
Wow! You sure did spend a lot on the robbery...

JAGGER  
Don't worry about it, we're  
millionaires!

ENZO  
You stuck to the budget, right?

AMELIA  
Of course we did.

ENZO  
Where are your receipts?

JAGGER  
In the top left cabinet.

Jagger points to a cabinet. Enzo opens it and finds a giant bag overflowing with receipts.

Enzo flips through the receipts.

ENZO  
This is a lot of money. \$5,000 for  
close-up magic lessons?

AMELIA  
We needed to learn how to create  
diversions.

ENZO  
But did you need to learn from  
David Blaine?

AMELIA  
Good point.  
(muttering to Jagger)  
What a cheapskate.

ENZO  
I'm not cheap! I'm trying to make  
sure we actually turn a profit.

Jagger puts his hand on Enzo's shoulder firmly.

JAGGER  
I'm sure we made a profit, we got a  
million dollars. But if you really  
want, I'll count it on our new  
money counter.

ENZO  
You bought a money counter? How  
much did it cost?

JAGGER  
It was only, like, 800 bucks.

Enzo flips out.

ENZO  
Why the hell would you do that?!

AMELIA  
Because it matches our new Rolexes.

Amelia and Jagger pull down their sleeves each having an ornate Rolex on their left hand.

JAGGER  
And they go with our designer tracksuits.

Amelia and Jagger point to the Gucci symbol on their tracksuits.

ENZO  
You better have made that money back.

JAGGER  
We made the money back and did it with style!

AMELIA  
We had to get watches for the heist. How else would we know when to cue the marching band?

Enzo facepalms.

ENZO  
You've got to be kidding me. You guys are the most wasteful people I've ever met.

JAGGER  
Listen, Scrooge-- we worked hard for this stuff.

ENZO  
The heist only took 20 minutes!

AMELIA  
You know what else only took 20 minutes? The moon landing.

ENZO  
No, it did not!

AMELIA  
Actually, I watched a video on  
TikTok that said--

ENZO  
I'm going to stop you right there.  
You two are going to bankrupt the  
operation.

Jagger looks offended. Jagger points with emphasis at Enzo.  
Each finger has an oversized golden ring on it.

JAGGER  
How dare you accuse us of  
overspending?

ENZO  
(seething with rage)  
What's on your hand there, Jagger?

JAGGER  
Well, we had to get the bling to  
match the Rolexes.

ENZO  
I never should've hired interns.

AMELIA  
Look, sometimes you have to spend  
money to make money. Which means if  
we spend a ton of money, we'll make  
a ton of money.

JAGGER  
It's like what I told the architect  
when we were building that replica  
of the bank--

ENZO  
You paid an architect to build a  
miniature model?

Jagger facepalms his forehead.

JAGGER  
A miniature model? Shoot. We didn't  
even think of that.

ENZO  
You've got to be kidding me!

AMELIA

We needed a full-size model. You see, I'm much more of a hands-on learner.

ENZO

It was a mistake trusting you with something this big. This was the perfect robbery, and you ruined it!

JAGGER

It's not that big of a deal. We really only bought the essentials. Walkie-talkies, explosives, fidget putty--

ENZO

Fidget putty isn't essential!

JAGGER

Yeah, it is. What if I get really bored during heists and I need to fidget? What do you expect me to do?! Twiddle my thumbs?!

JAGGER

It can't be that bad, can it?  
There's no way we spent more than a  
million dollars.

AMELIA

I don't know. We did hire a Beyonce  
impersonator to perform our exit  
music. . .

The money counter dings. Amelia moves the small stack of  
money onto the large pile, then checks the money counter. Her  
face goes pale.

JAGGER

So that big pile is how much we  
made, right?

Jagger points to the large pile of cash. Amelia shakes her  
head.

AMELIA

No.

JAGGER

Okay, so how much did we make?

AMELIA

\$100 million dollars.

JAGGER

That's great! How much did we lose?

AMELIA

\$250 million dollars.

Concerned, Amelia and Jagger look at the large pile of cash.

JAGGER

How the hell did we lose more money  
than we made?

AMELIA

I don't know but we have to fix  
this somehow.

JAGGER

There's no fixing it. Enzo is going  
to kill us.

AMELIA

Unless we find a way to make it all  
back. . .

JAGGER  
Are you thinking what I'm thinking?

AMELIA  
I'll get the Rolexes.

JAGGER  
I'll get the fidget putty.
